Purpose: Assemble equipment according to prints and/or verbal direction.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ◆ Assemble mechanical components according to specifications using proper tools and verifying conformance of parts.
- ◆ Identify and communicate with project team regarding build issues and documentation.
- ◆ Debug assemblies and machines by identifying and correcting problems affecting proper operation.
- ◆ Prepare equipment for customer shipment.
- ◆ Clean, maintain and organize work area and all equipment.
- ◆ Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- ◆ Manufacturing experience required
- ◆ Ability and willingness to multi-task and learn new responsibilities
